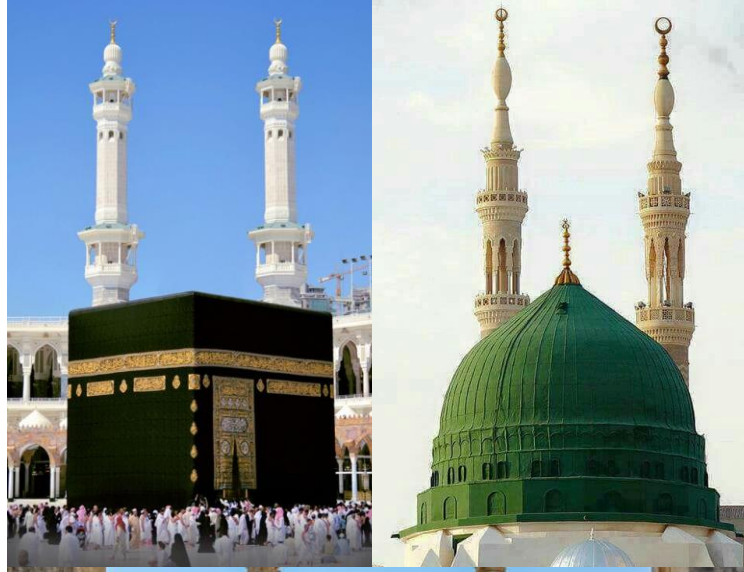

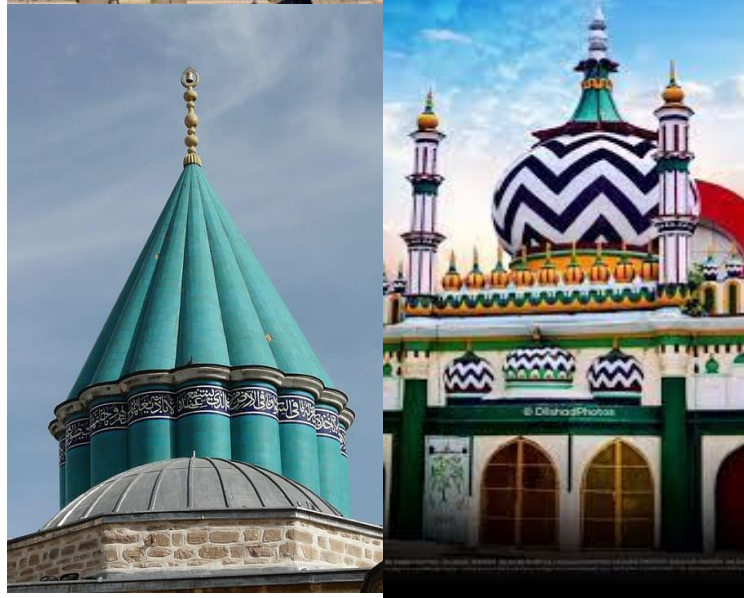

Assalamu Alaikum Wa Rahmatullahi Wa Barakatuh,

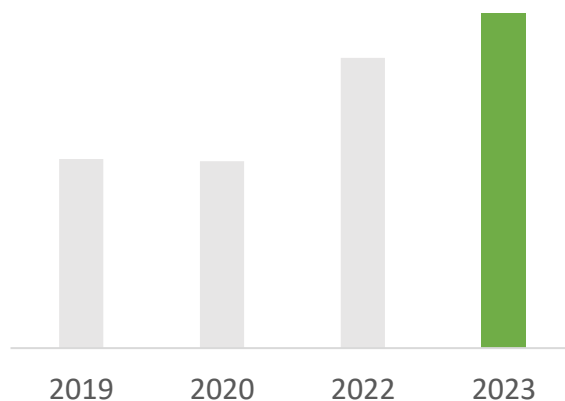

Overview


The Pretoria Muslim Trust has had several developments which we are proud to announce:

1  **Solar Roll-Out Across All Masjids:** All three masjids are powered by Solar. This initiative will shield us from the ever-increasing Eskom tariffs and loadshedding. We would like to thank the donors for this support

2  **University Bursaries:** The PMT's university project has indicated its first signs of success with our first student graduating with a BCom HR qualification. May Allah allow our students to ease the financial burdens in their families

3  **Gas Project – Welfare:** The welfare committee donated over 400 gas stoves, food hampers and blankets to the community. The response from the recipients highlighted the immense need for this

4  **PMT Going Global:** The Pretoria Muslim Trust has launched itself across a variety of social media networks, including YouTube, TikTok, Facebook and Instagram. This garnered over 30 000 viewers per month

5  **PMT Madressa & Hifz Classes:** The PMT Masjid and School Committees have launched Madressa and Hifz Classes under the directive of Shaykh Noor Aswad and Moulana Anwar

6  **Outstanding Results PMT College:** The school committee has achieved the highest Afrikaans average in the district for the second year in a row. This highlights the development of the school curriculum and efforts of the teaching staff and students

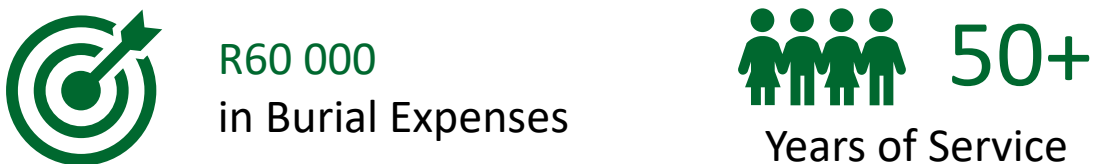
The burial committee has been operational for several decades, with countless funerals undertaken. PMT had the first burial committee in the area and will strive to keep serving the community.

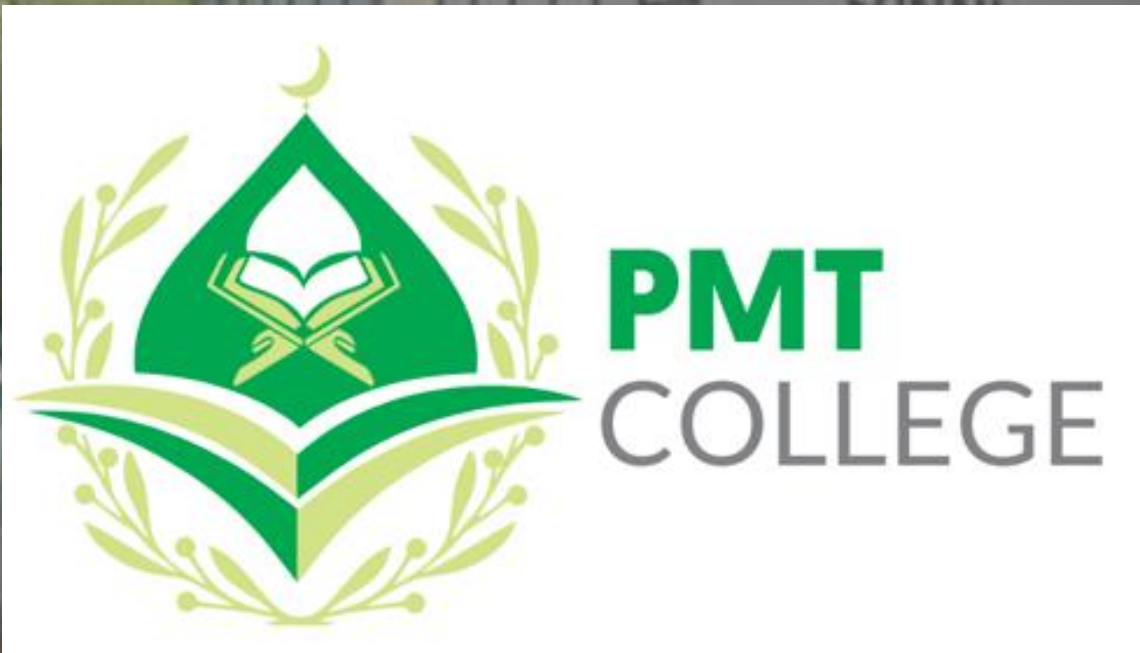

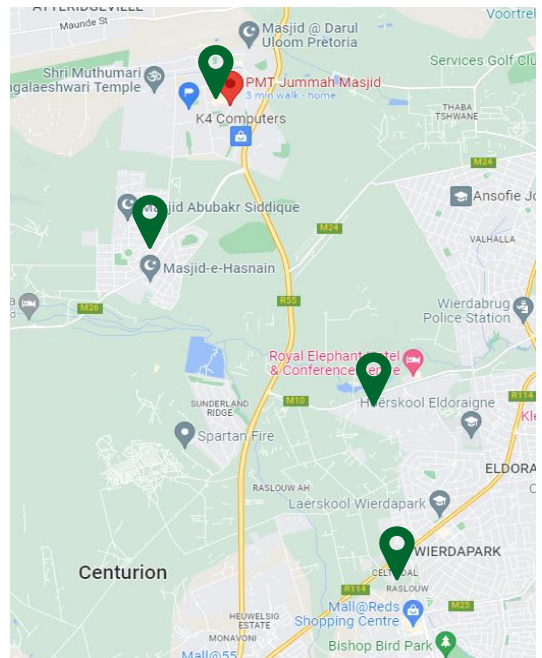
