Assalamu Alaikum Wa Rahmatullahi Wa Barakatuh,







Analysis of Collections




Analysis of Revenue







The burial committee has been operational for several decades, with countless funerals undertaken. PMT had the first burial committee in the area and will strive to keep serving the community.




Lilah Collections 2024: R60 000


2023 - Overview

Currently, every month, there are over 500 families collecting vouchers from the welfare committee. Without the welfare committee, many community members would be in a much worse position.







The PMT Care & Relief requires R30 000.00 for maintenance and operations. We aim to develop this into a fully-fledged care offering for our community.


