### Organisation-wide Rebranding

### **Hearse Project**

The financial statements for the 2020 Financial Year have been posted on the notice boards of the mosques.

The board has selected Xero as our accounting tool and keeping real time and up to date management accounts. The external audit for FY21 in underway and the AFS will be released as soon as it is available

### PMT Welfare and Masjid Offices



In an effort to reduce rental costs the organisation has relocated the Welfare offices to a PMT owned building. The new offices are located on the Corner of 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue Laudium.

### **Borehole Project**



With the water crises that Laudium faced in the 2021 year the organisation assessed our lands to find Borehole suitable sites. This was identified at one of our Masjids and a borehole was installed with a JoJo tank to supply the Masjid.





### Solar Project

The Masjid committee has identified solar as an important driver for the next few years. Not only will this shield us from the tariff increases Eskom keeps imposing but it will allow us to navigate ourselves through load-shedding and unnecessary power cuts



40% of expenses

The mosques largest expenses arise from Lights and Water, implementing a solar project will require a larger capital in the early phases but save the organisation on electrical costs in the future. Making it an excellent investment in Sadqah-e-Jaariyah.




# **Burial Committee**


#### Overview

# On-site Handyman


With an additional budget we will be able to hire an onsite handyman to take care of day to day maintenance within the organisation



# Families being helped

Around 2000 people being helped a month

Depending on available budget the welfare committee also runs several other projects such as:

- Ramadaan shoe drive
- Ramadaan Vouchers
- Eid Vouchers
- Chicken Vouchers for Ramadaan
- Food Parcels



Currently on a monthly basis there is over 500 families collecting vouchers from the welfare committee. Without the welfare committee a lot of people in the community would be in a much worse position

In recent years due to constraints in budgets the welfare committee was not able to conduct the projects mentioned above. However, if we can collect the R5.6m goal we can provide all of the above to our community.

Donations are fully distributed to recipients, no commissions, fees or remunerations are made to the committee members




4 Active Bases


