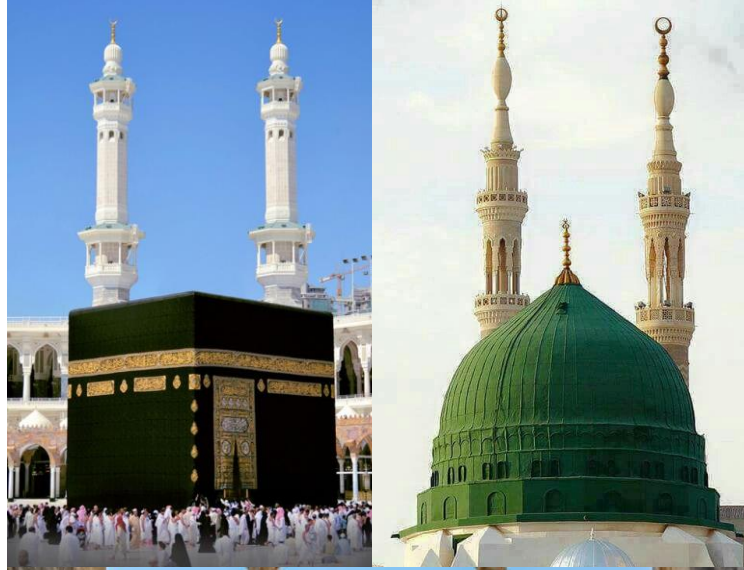

As Salamu Alaikum, Dearest Brothers and Sisters

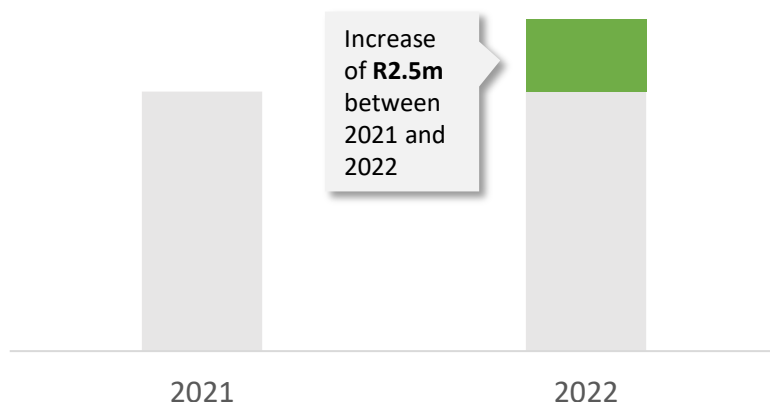
On the behalf of the Pretoria Muslim Trust, we would like to thank you for your support. The organisation is now out of a critical position but rather in a position to grow.

Developments Over the 2022 Year


Overview


The Pretoria Muslim Trust has had several developments which we are proud to announce:


1  **Solar Roll-Out at the Jummah Masjid, Jewel Street:** The PMT Jummah Masjid has now gone off the grid. This initiative will shield us from the ever-increasing Eskom tariffs and loadshedding. We aim to expand our capacity to cater to blackouts in the 2024 year

2  **Revamp of the Meelad-e-Mustafa Masjid, Bengal Street:** The Meelad-e-Mustafa Masjid was in dire need of maintenance. Waterproofing issues and related water damage were rectified

3  **Ghousia Masjid:** The Masjid committee have upgraded the flooring in the Ghousia Masjid and changed to a brand new carpet

4  **Smart Classrooms at the PMT College:** PMT College has completely revamped two classrooms (Grades 1 & 2). This is to incorporate technology-driven learning across our school

5  **Launch of the PMT Website & Knowledge Network:** As part of our technology strategy, we have launched an online donations portal as well as a job portal connecting Muslim employers to Muslim employees

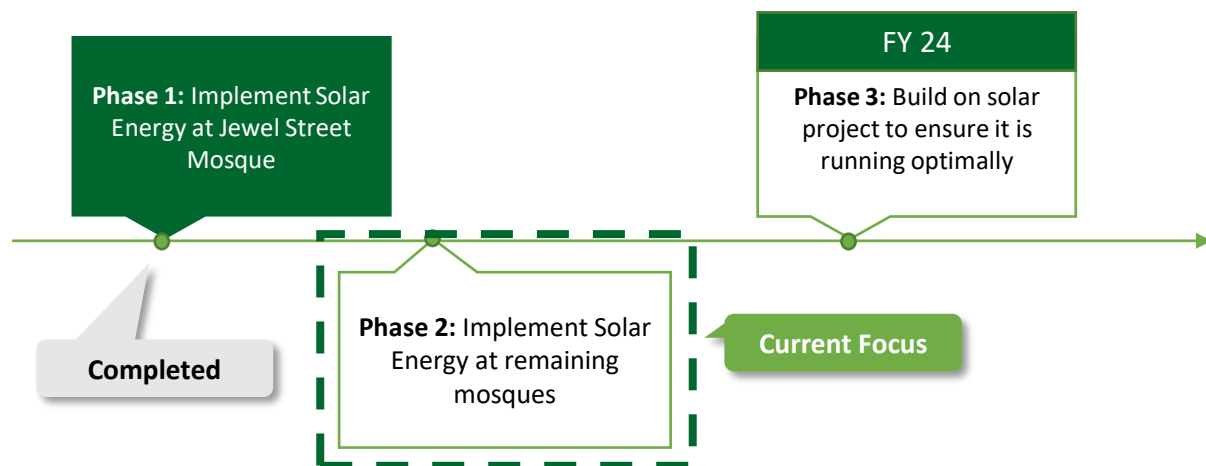

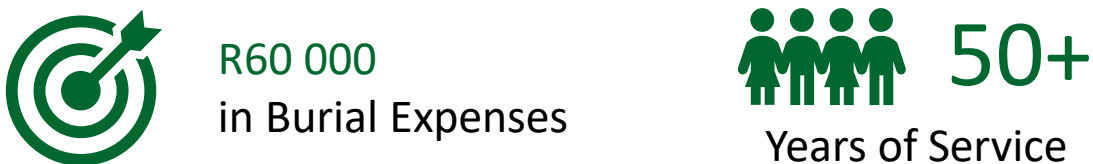
The burial committee has been operational for several decades, with countless funerals undertaken. PMT had the first burial committee in the area and will strive to keep serving the community.

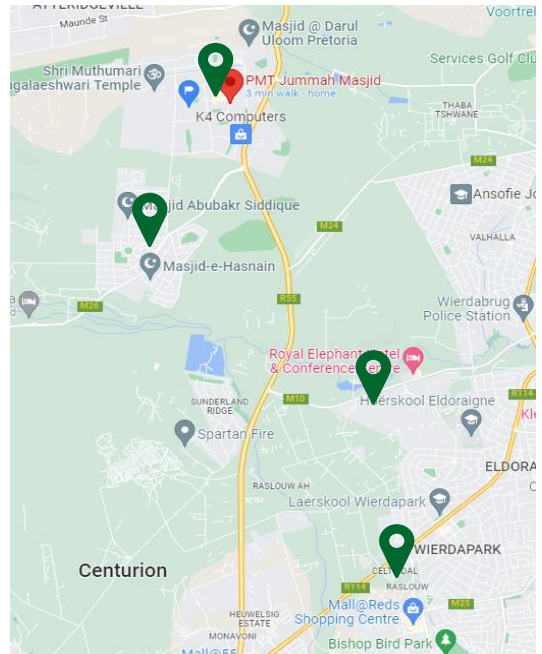
